### **TOURIST TAX**

(Public notice to be displayed inside the accommodation facility)

From 01 June 2019, the Municipality of Oristano has established the tourist tax approved by City Council with the resolution n. 17 dated on March 29th 2019. The tax applies to the overnight stays of non-residents in the City of Oristano, for a maximum of 7 consecutive nights. Therefore, all visitors spending at least one night in Oristano will have to pay the tax directly to the accommodation facility where they are staying. The accommodation will consequently pay the amount to the Municipality.

The amount ranges from €. 0,50 to €. 2,00 per night, according to the type, class and number of stars of the establishment. The tax rate for this accommodation is Euro ..... per person and per night.

The staff are bound to provide all necessary information on exemptions from payment of the tax. Among others there are the following exemptions (with reference to the Article 5 of Regulation approved by the abovementioned City Council resolution n. 17 dated on March 29th 2019):

- children up to the age of twelve;
- tour leaders who provide assistance to groups (one exemption for every twenty-five people); bus drivers.
- sick and helpers at healthcare facilities;
- public security personnel (policemen, fire fighters etc).
- volunteers in natural disaster and emergencies;
- Off-site students up to the age of twenty-six enrolled in degree courses on the University of Oristano.
- Erasmus students (or Erasmus type international exchange programs participants).

Revenues from the Tourist Tax will finance actions for the preservation of the city's artistic heritage and for the improvement of services for all tourists.
